- Website - Kurt did a great, and unilateral, modification of the RW website but it is now sitting relatively abandoned with no current information as he works behind the scenes to 'make it better'

Website – difficult to keep current
Need input from organizers
Kurt suggest team info/press releases
Suggested the organizers nominate a competitor to do an after event write-up (both Stage/TSD)
New webhost in place; Kurt taking care of it
Committee to work on content, succession: Kurt, Adam, Dave, Marcel

- New events in the WCRC
Suggest we agree that stage rallies need to be run successfully as a stand-alone rally before being considered for inclusion in the championship. The recent attempts to add two events in Rally West hurt the championship when they were unable to be run. Inclusion in the WCRC must be by mutual agreement with RPM and RW.
- New Stage Events
Strongly recommended that we require new stage events, with new organisers, to be run as ralliesprints or test days before being run as a stand alone stage event. This will give the organisers and competitors a good feel for what to expect from the event without the logistics and commitment involved with a stage rally.
This recommendation should not be “cast in concrete” to allow for a variety of circumstances.

Comments from the floor:

Substituting Big White worked well (with a 5 month lead time)
Don't add events after calendar is set
Coordination ladder to climb – organizer to club to Rallywest (& BC)
In terms of a new event, the organizing team has to demonstrate they can run an event before it gets included in the regional series. At the discretion of the Rally West board to recommend if it moves on and in what form. (Must be observed as a club event before it can move up to regional)
New organizing teams have to run a ralliesprint or test day, before a stand alone event
There are always situations that rules don't cover
The organizing team is a big factor
New locations create new factors also

- Keiths comment re: Region President
Although I was elected to both the region president position and the CARS board representative for RW, I strongly recommend the meeting elect or appoint someone to the region president position. The region has not been getting the attention it deserves from me and with almost certainty that I will be leaving the RW board next year this is a great way to groom someone to the position.

See above under elections

- Black Ice Rally
As this event has already missed its first deadline for paperwork with CARS, sanctioning it as a stage

rally will be next to impossible. (Anyone who has dealt with Linda and late paperwork will know what I mean)

Beyond that, hosting it as a stage rally, one week before Cochrane, will hurt both events with the Black Ice Rally suffering the most. I can't express strongly enough how valuable and successful this event could be as a test day! (with intent to hold it as a stage event next year)

*** The ERC will not be running the Black Ice Rally this year. As you mentioned, the timing is too rushed, and will interfere with too many people's plans. We are now planning (on Feb 27th) to run a Rallycross and Test & Tune day. More details to follow this weekend.

Strongly suggested that someone look at the track after the Numb Bum takes place. Looking at suitability for a rally. Tom Machnik volunteered

- **AGM and Awards Banquet**

With Big White Continuing next year, and a valuable addition to the WCRC calendar, we need to take a good look at when/how we want to run our AGM and awards.

I still think there is merit in the idea of possibly doing an awards breakfast after the last event of the season, in big white, since most of the 'players' will be there. It would mean having 'presenter' awards and sending out the 'keepers' later, but at least the recognition would happen in front of the rest of the competitors.

General consensus was to keep AGM separate from an event

Make a party out of it? Prizes? Sell tickets in advance for a dinner?

Red Deer location?

Agreed to separate AGM and awards, so that necessary business could be completed before the end of the year, but to allow for a final WCRC event in December.

Rallywest President's Report

First let me apologise for not being able to attend the AGM in person. On my return home from the CARS AGM I was struck with a cold that has left me unable to function for the past week.

The past year was a challenging one for Rallywest and the WCRC with the loss of two stage events from the regional calendar. Mountain Trials was cancelled due to forest fire dangers and Bighorn ran into problems getting road permissions. Big White was nominated as a replacement for Mountain Trials and proved to be an excellent event, particularly for a first attempt at organising.

The BC stage events continue to rely on support from Alberta volunteers – Pacific Forest counting 17 workers that made the trip from Alberta. Big White also benefited from Albertans in many of the key roles.

Our TSD events have drawn well this year, but could use some more attention. We show a number of one time entrants in a number of events, so retention appears to be an issue.

Much of my efforts over the past year have, as in previous years, been focussed at the CARS Board level and my duties as National Marketing Manager.

For the first time in many, many years, the CRC heads into its first event of the season with Partnership agreements in place that will cover the cost of television for the year as well as continued contingency programs. Despite being a 'tough economic year,' both Subaru and Yokohama have returned to the CRC as partners, bringing with them higher levels of commitment. The Subaru and Mitsubishi contingency programs continue with some changes coming for the Mitsubishi program. (no details yet) Yokohama is also sorting out the details of a contingency plan that is expected to pay out to class winners in both national and regional portions of national events.

There are at least two other companies that have expressed interest in working with the CRC, at a low level, so things are looking up.

On the CARS Board front, the 'ship' continues to turn. President Tom McGeer brings a very different style of governance than was seen under Jorge Dascalas, but the end goals are very much the same. Transparency and accountability drive much of the board's approach and while we haven't managed to get board minutes onto the website, we will be publishing them in the future. There have been format changes to the CARS budget and those will soon be carried over to the chart of accounts so that the board can finally compare expenses to the budget as a way of measuring performance. Previously, the day to day accounting, and year-end reporting, was organised differently than the budget.

We have a new accountant to do our financial 'review engagement.' Paul Hartl, a competitor from the Toronto area, takes this roll over from Eric Curtis.

The only other change on the board is a new Director from RPM. Ryan Matthews chose to not stand for election and has been replaced by Jennifer Daly who also inherits the position of CARS Secretary on the board. During the deliberation of the election of the CARS President, even though there was only one candidate, the board discussed the importance of having someone who has a working knowledge of the board step into the position. Both Jorge and Tom faced hardships with being thrown into the deep end of the job, making their first years somewhat less than enjoyable. Tom has suggested that he will not continue beyond the end of this year in the role of President but that he would continue on in a marketing role. This could have me considering changing jobs to the President's position by this time next year. Rallywest should be thinking now of who would be a good successor to me as I may not continue on the CARS board regardless of what happens with the President's position.

Development of a new website is underway and its features will eventually include a portal for license applications and event registrations with an online payment option. This will be a huge step forward for CARS and the CRC.

The latest 'must do' item on Tom's list is to work towards getting an electronic timing system in place for the CRC. I have repeatedly cautioned him, and the board, that doing so isn't as easy as it looks, but he is forging ahead with investigation. The association will not likely be in a position to ever outright buy a system so you can expect to see a 'lease to own' arrangement with a timing equipment levy similar to what we presently have in the west.

That's about all I have for now.
