Assurance of Voluntary Compliance (AVC)

An AVC is the driver’s written commitment to a Scrutineer and TSD Organizer that a contravention of the RallyWest Regulation will be corrected before the next TSD Rally.

An AVC *may* be used to correct minor infractions but never in situations that constitute a danger. Where there is agreement and willingness to do so, the Scrutineer and TSD Organizer *may* accept the commitment of the driver that the situation will be corrected.

Failure to correct the deficiency identified in an AVC will lead to disqualification from all future Calgary Sports Car Club (CSCC) TSD Rallies until the deficiency is corrected.

Examples of infractions that *may* (or may not) be accepted under an AVC include but are not limited to:

- A single bulb burned out
- Fire extinguisher fully charged but no proof of 2 year recharge
- A non-critical item missing from the first aid kit
