B2-1 – Service Park Hours

The service park will remain open overnight. However, after 10pm, teams are asked to be considerate of the residents neighboring the service park, particularly if doing engine/exhaust work.

B2-2 – Service Park Assignments

B2-2 – Route Change

Teams will receive fitting kits (RAM mount, 2 antennae, grey power lead, Yellow RallySafe power lead), if needed, at registration, these **MUST** be installed, with power connected, before your car goes through tech inspection. If you have a loaner fitting kit, please be prepared to help remove the kit after the final control.

We ask that ALL teams mark the wifi lead coming from the external antenna at the connector end as it is not used during the event and we would like it to be easy to identify.

B2-9 – Columbia Valley Spa

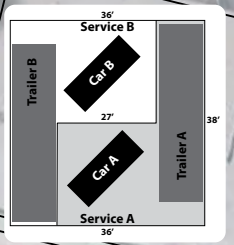

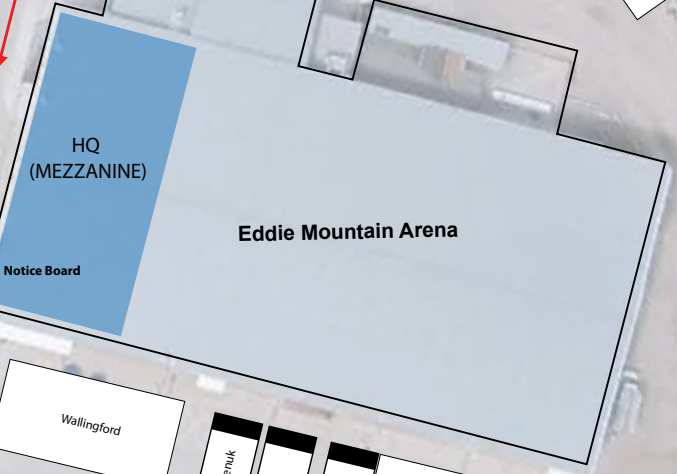
