3.1 Virtual Chicane Locations

There was a lack of clarity about the virtual chicane locations for the event. Sign boards for both are in the correct locations.

Loop: The Virtual Chicane on the Loop stage (SS1 & SS2) is to slow the cars prior to instruction #4 in the routebook. The Chicane distance remains the same as Bulletin #2.

Prairie Creek North: The Chicane starts 0.92km after the water hole, starting at 21.57km and ending at 21.67km.

Prairie Creek South: There is no chicane on SS3 & SS5.

3.2 Prairie Creek South Stop Control Change

The stop control for Prairie Creek South has been moved 0.10km farther to the start of the bridge, to allow a longer distance for stopping due to the poor road conditions.

3.3 RallySafe Reminder

Teams are asked to complete installation of RallySafe units Saturday night, and put the unit through a full boot-up sequence, which requires that the car be outside so it can get GPS satellite lock.

Cars that are being stored inside overnight should remove the power to your RallySafe unit overnight to avoid draining the battery.

Teams are asked to power up their RallySafe units before heading out to the stages Sunday morning, unless they are travelling in an enclosed trailer. If you are transporting in an enclosed trailer, then power up your RallySafe unit as soon as you remove the car from the trailer.
